*Basic ESA Requirements**

- An individual is assessed and found to meet criteria as having or being regarded as having a disability *and*
- There is an identifiable relationship between the animal's presence/qualities and the alleviation of one or more of the individual's disability-related symptoms.

*List is not exhaustive and exclusionary criteria may apply.

Timeframe

- Appointments are required and are subject to counselor's availability.
- Appointments are typically scheduled at least one week apart.
- The assessment process takes a approximately 3 appointments and may take longer if recent treatment records are not available or if further assessment is needed.

Are there guarantees?

- No! Letters are only issued when the assessment reveals that an individual meets criteria and may benefit from an ESA letter.
- An individual may request ESA accommodation(s) for housing with an ESA letter but accommodations cannot be guaranteed.
- Refunds are not available.
